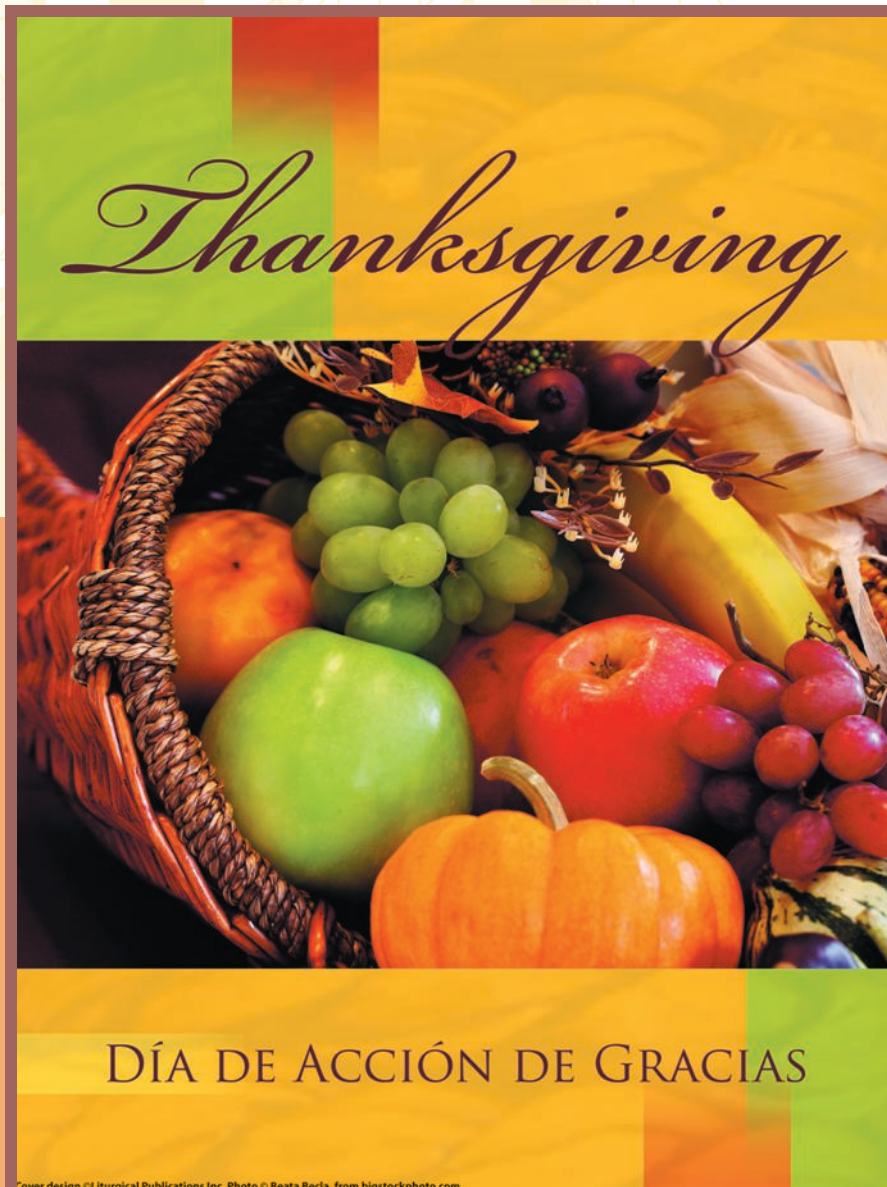


Campaña Católica para el Desarrollo Humano
